Monthly Report Oct 65 Considerable effort was expended by the Division in converting our present 1401 computer programs to COBOL language. The CRS Requirements Program has been rewritten and debugged. The programs for Intellofax, GR Ground Photography and OBI Map Ly are in progress of being converted and we expect to have the assembly and debug procedure completed by 15 Nov 65.

Nov 65 As requested by OCS, the Programming Staff has converted Intellofax, the ORR Map Library, GR Ground Photography and CGS Requirements computer programs from SPS and Auto-Coder 1401 Language to 1710 COBAL Language.

Dec 65 An ~~aperture card~~ IBM type 083 (aperture card sorter) that operates at 1,000 cards per minute and a 519 aperture card reproducer have been installed. This equipment along with two other pieces are to support the new Document Delivery System and the OBI Map Library System.

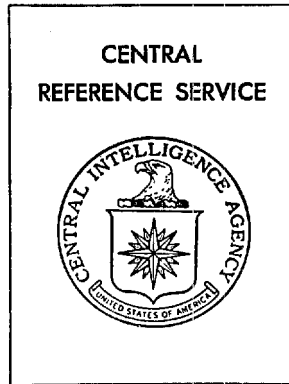
25X1A2g Jan 66 At the request of [redacted] Programming Group, we key punched instructions and provided machine support on some of their programs which are to be used on the CDC Optical Character Reader and the 360 Current Awareness Programs.

Feb 66 An Itek Model 18-24 Reader Printer that reproduces prints from 16mm and 35mm roll microfilm, sheet film and aperture cards was installed in Room GEO433. This unit will replace the Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing Co. 200R Reader Printer.
