As requested in your letter of October 22, 1946, this office has requested the temporary assignment of Mr. [REDACTED] 25X1A
[REDACTED] from the Office of Intelligence Collection and Dissemination (OCD) to the Central Intelligence Group, pending formal transfer. 25X1A

OCD agrees to release Mr. [REDACTED] to CIG on a temporary assignment beginning November 1, 1946, for one month. CIG may, therefore, process Mr. [REDACTED]'s appointment to become effective on or before December 1, 1946.

This temporary detail is approved with the stipulation that Mr. [REDACTED] may be recalled by OCD, when necessary, to work on any unfinished project which is presently his assignment. If required, these recalls will be of short duration and will be cleared informally between OCD and CIG.

Mr. [REDACTED] has been cleared by the State Department for Departmental security and no further clearance for CIG will be initiated unless specifically requested by CIG.

We shall await CIG acceptance of the foregoing agreement before instructing Mr. [REDACTED] to report to CIG on November 1.
