
I am very disturbed about reports reaching me concerning the selection of a firm to design the new CIA headquarters building addition at Langley, Virginia.

According to my information, the firm CRS, Inc., of Houston, Texas, was selected as the best qualified by your own Contract Review Board, but that you bypassed CRS, Inc., and selected the number two firm because of questions regarding foreign ownership of CRS, Inc.

CRS, Inc. is an established, reputable American firm that has done business with the Defense Department for many years. I recognize the sensitive nature of this particular design project, but I know that CRS, Inc., can satisfy any concerns you may have about the security of the design and the design team.

I urge you to reexamine your decision and invite CRS, Inc., to enter into negotiations for this contract.
