INITIAL MESSAGE

The enclosed article from the 25 August edition of the LA Times will be of interest to you and in preparing for the upcoming HPSCI arms control briefing.

The Committee is well aware that as an intelligence agency we are not in a position to comment on US policy. If, however, policy related questions arise, they will be keyed to statements made by Secretary of Defense Weinberger in his 25 August letter. Mr. Gore, for instance, may inquire about the intelligence provided to the administration which resulted in it's decision that "...to deter nuclear war, the United States must demonstrate that it is capable of fighting a prolonged nuclear war-perhaps as long as six months-with the Soviet Union."

Although it will be difficult not to gravitate toward the policy-making sphere, I am confident that every effort will be made to confine the questioning to technical aspects of arms control.
