

NSCIC Working Group Action Program  
Evaluation of Intelligence Product

- Set up a task force similar in composition to the Working Group.
- Have a Working Group member serve as Chairman of the task force.
- Charge the task force with:
  - evaluating the current intelligence publications of the Intelligence Community to include at least the following:  
  
National Intelligence Daily (special handling)  
National Intelligence Bulletin  
Defense Intelligence Notices  
SIGINT Summary  
DIA Intelligence Appraisal  
CIA Weekly Review  
INR Intelligence Notes
  - using a three-month base for the study
  - reporting its evaluation and any recommendations for changes to the Working Group by October 15, 1975.
- The following should be among the criteria used for content evaluation:
  - timeliness
  - clarity
  - relevancy
  - uniqueness
  - accuracy
  - completeness
  - identification and evaluation of source
  - resolution or evaluation of conflicting reports
- The following should be among the topics considered in evaluating the externals of the product:
  - classification
  - distribution
  - format
  - presentation (to include use of pictures, maps, charts, etc.)
