9. MISSION READOUT: THE DOUBLY SECURED COMPLEX IS IN AN EARLY STAGE OF CONSTRUCTION AND CONSISTS OF THE TRACKING/GUIDANCE FACILITY, A SUPPORT AREA, AND THE LAUNCH AREA MAIN ROAD. THE COMPLEX WILL PROBABLY CONSIST OF THREE LAUNCH SITES CONSTRUCTED SIMILARLY TO THOSE AT THE KHABAROVSK, KURESSAARE, AND PERESLAVL-ZALESSKIY PROBABLE LONG RANGE SAM LAUNCH COMPLEXES. THE COMPLEX [REDACTED] AND IS LOCATED 70 NM FROM BOTH THE KOSTROMA AND SHARYA COMPLEXES.

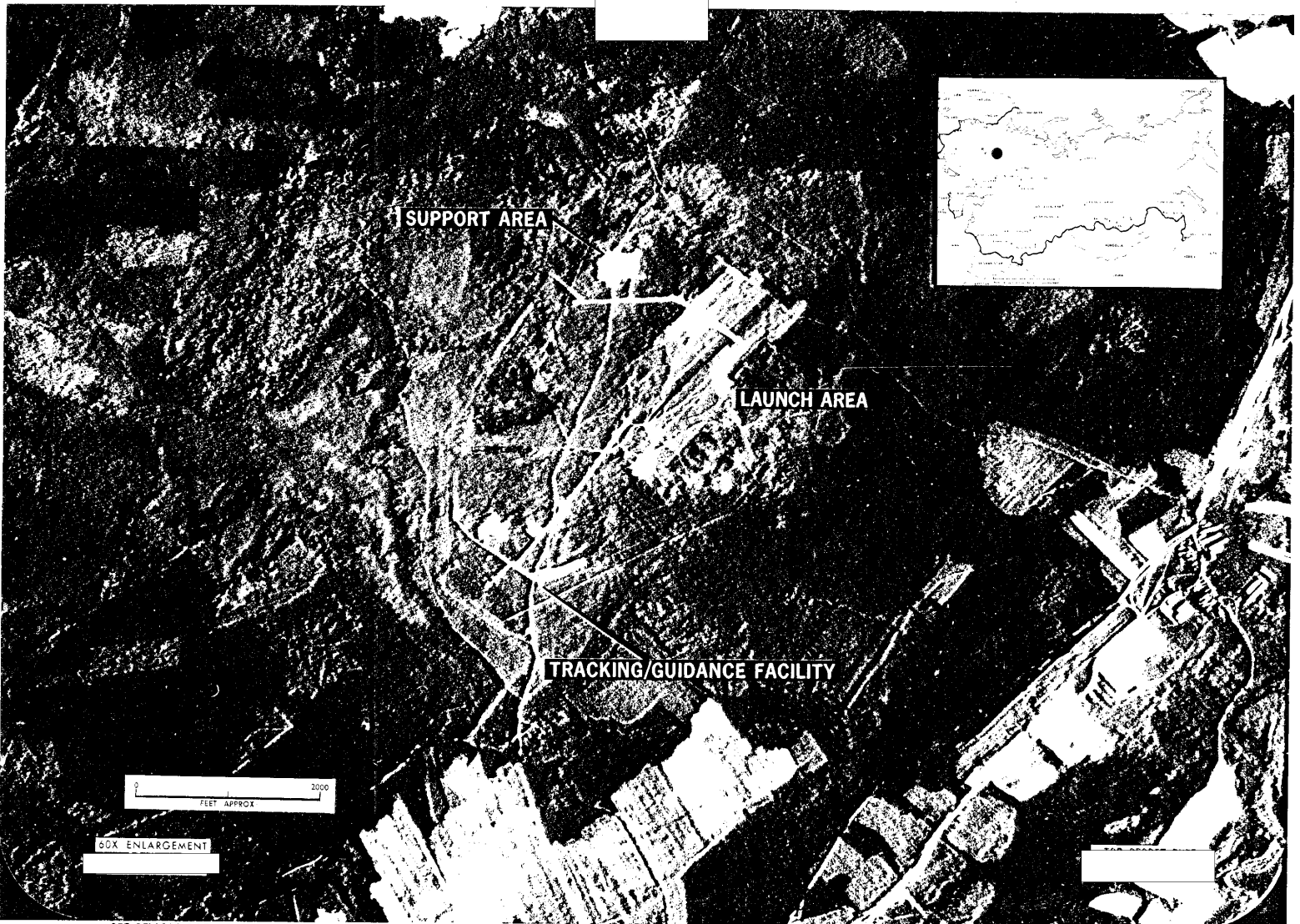
