wrote to John Bross to urge that the new CIA Center not duplicate current efforts being carried on elsewhere. He wanted three questions answered by both CIA and DOD: What are required tasks not now being done? What tasks are not now being performed satisfactorily which can be improved with current efforts being reprogrammed? What tasks require duplication in order to improve finished intelligence?

DOD having current internal review and will provide CIA its findings -- requested that CIA do the same.
