SUBJECT: Request to Reprogram 1984 Funds f/u/w Data Terminal
Installation Acceleration Program

1. As you are aware, the operational effectiveness of virtually every Agency component is being adversely affected by a shortage of data terminals; e.g., Delta Data 7260T. The Office of Communications (OC) is currently hard pressed to effect 100 terminal installations per month, while requirements dictate the need for 300 installations per month. The shortfall continues to be a mounting backlog of installations and increased lead times for relocation of terminals.

2. To correct this shortfall, OC proposes to initiate a contract on 01 October 1983 which requires an increase of resources as follows:

18 contractors (drillers, cable installers, etc.)	\$1,080K
Materials (cable, hardware, etc.)	60K
TOTAL	<u>\$1,140K</u>

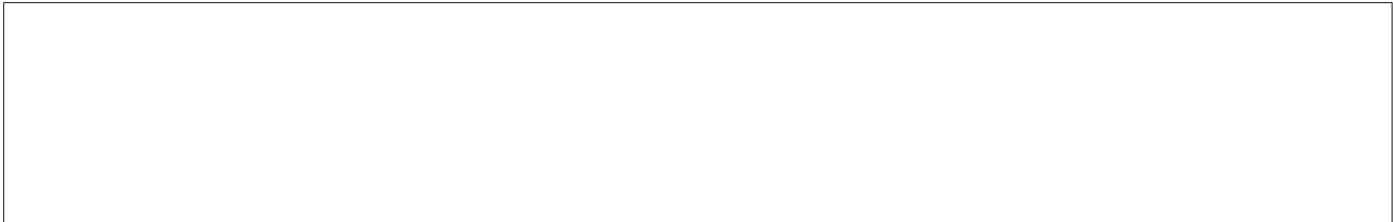
