SAFE Success

1. On Thursday, 30 June, a SIG-IEP meeting was held at the White House to discuss negotiating instructions for the US delegation at the UN Conference on Trade and Development. That morning, State Department officials were preparing briefing material for Deputy Secretary Dam who would be the principal speaker at the meeting. OGI/ECD/TW was preparing briefing material for [redacted] who would represent the CIA at the meeting. Because we have access to the SAFE system, we were able to pass on intelligence information to the State Department concerning late developments at UNCTAD which we would not have had in time for the meeting if we had relied on COLTS or some other method of distribution. The information I passed to State played a key role in clarifying the state of play at UNCTAD for participants at the SIG-IEP. (Because it came from State the participants never knew they were receiving intelligence information.) In addition to the value of providing the intelligence information, because we had SAFE, we were able to pass to [redacted] a cable from the head of the US delegation to UNCTAD outlining the current status of issues to be discussed at the SIG-IEP. [redacted]
