25X1 1. This asks that you reserve the dates 10-12 May for the
purpose of attending a conference on Ethics and the Profession
of Intelligence [Redacted]

2. At its 7-8 January meeting, the Editorial Board of
Studies in Intelligence, under the chairmanship of the Executive
Director, approved a proposal that the Center for the Study of
Intelligence conduct such a conference. No less than law,
medicine or the US military, our profession--having endured a
period of testing--is seeking to reaffirm its footings and to do
so in a structured and intellectually persuasive way. It is
CSI's and the Board's hope that a collegial gathering of the
kind we propose for May will result in a thorough vetting of
those ethical issues that concern many of us and a reaffirmation
of professional principles.

3. CSI, working with the Hastings Center in New York and
the Joseph Kennedy Institute at Georgetown, will prepare an agenda
that will provide for formal lectures, small group discussions and
plenary exchanges. The participants will include Board members,
Associate Deputy Directors, the Interdirectorate Seminar, a staff
member from both Congressional Committees, and one or two guests
from the Department of Justice.

4. We hope that you will participate.
