THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT BY FRG DEPUTY PRESS SPOKESMAN SUDHOFF ON THE INF PORTION OF ANDROPOV'S DECEMBER 21 SPEECH WAS MADE IN THE AFTERNOON OF THE SAME DAY, BEFORE RECEIPT AND DELIVERY ON MOFNING OF DECEMBER 22 OF THE U.S. STATEMENT CONTAINED REFTEL.

BEGIN TEXT: (UNOFFICIAL EMBASSY TRANSLATION)

THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WILL ANALYZE THE CONTENT OF THIS SPEECH VERY CAREFULLY AND VERY SERIOUSLY. WE SHALL EXAMINE ITS CONTENT WITH A VIEW TO FINDING OUT WHAT IT CAN PRODUCE FOR US IN TERMS OF MORE SECURITY AND BALANCE IN THIS FIELD. THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WILL ASK ITS PARTNERS TO EXAMINE THIS SPEECH AS SERIOUSLY AS WE DO, AS THEY ALWAYS HAVE, AND AS THE AMERICANS ALWAYS HAVE IN GENEVA.

WHAT WE THUS FAR KNOW OF THE TEXT OF MR. ANDROPOV'S SPEECH STEMS FROM NEWS AGENCY REPORTS. I WOULD NEVERTHELESS LIKE TO VOICE SOME IDEAS WHICH I FEEL DESERVE TO BE STRESSED. IT LOOKS AS IF THE SUBSTANCE OF WHAT MR. ANDROPOV SAID

CORRESPONDS WITH THE PROPOSALS WHICH THE SOVIET UNION ALREADY SUBMITTED IN GENEVA AND WHICH ALREADY WERE THE SUBJECT OF PRESS REPORTS AT HOME AND ABROAD.

WE CONTINUE TO BE INTERESTED IN A BILATERAL ZERO SOLUTION. IF, AS INDICATED IN MR. ANDROPOV'S SPEECH, THE SOVIET UNION WISHES TO KEEP A PART OF ITS INTERMEDIATE-RANGE ARSENAL TARGETED UPON EUROPE, THE VERY ESSENTIAL ELEMENT OF BALANCE IN THIS FIELD SEEMS TO BE LACKING, AND IT SEEMS THAT THE SOVIET UNION WISHES TO PRESERVE ITS MONOPOLY IN THE FIELD OF INTERMEDIATE-RANGE MISSILES.

IT SOUNDS VERY NICE WHEN MR. ANDROPOV SAYS, ACCORDING TO THE ADN REPORT, THAT THE SOVIET UNION MERELY WISHES TO HAVE IN EUROPE EXACTLY AS MANY MISSILE BASES AS GREAT BRITAIN AND FRANCE HAVE, BUT THIS WOULD LOCK IN A SOVIET SUPERIORITY IN THE FIELD OF INTERMEDIATE-RANGE MISSILES WHICH IS OF SUCH DECISIVE IMPORTANCE FOR THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY. A SUPERIORITY WHICH NEITHER THE PAST NOR THE PRESENT FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FINDS POLITICALLY ACCEPTABLE IN VIEW OF OUR SECURITY INTERESTS. AND WHEN MR. ANDROPOV THEN SAYS THAT, IN SHORT, IT IS NOW THE TURN OF THE U.S., I HAVE THE IMPRESSION THAT CAUSE AND EFFECT ARE BEING SKILLFULLY CONFUSED HERE. IT WAS NOT THE U.S. WHICH FIRST STATIONED INTERMEDIATE-RANGE MISSILES IN EUROPE. AND I SUGGEST YOU RE-READ WHAT THE FOREIGN MINISTER SAID IN THE BUNDESTAG LAST FRIDAY: WE WANT NO INTERMEDIATE-RANGE MISSILES EITHER IN THE SAST OR IN THE WEST.

AND WHAT THE GENEVA NEGOTIATIONS ARE SEEKING TO ACCOMPLISH IS A DISMANTLING ON THE ONE SIDE AND MAKING IT SUPERFLUOUS TO STATION INF ON THE OTHER SIDE. WE HAVE TO LOOK WITH SCEPTICISM AT SOVIET PROPOSALS THAT SEEK TO CEMENT THE STATUS QUO. END TEXT.
