TERMS OF REFERENCE

I. Background

- A. SSCI instructions to the DCI
- B. DCI obtains SIG(I) membership agreement for establishment of  
Advisory Commission

II. Scope of Commission Responsibilities

- A. Develop a clear-cut definition of multidisciplinary counterintelligence analysis requirements
- B. Assess strengths and weaknesses in current multidisciplinary counterintelligence analysis and production
- C. Identify areas where significant improvement can be achieved
- D. Develop practical recommendations for meeting requirements, to  
include numbers and skills of analysts, organizational location, and  
data base needs.

III. Composition of the Commission

- A. Membership to be selected by the DCI in consultation with the Attorney General and the Secretary of Defense
- B. Commission to be composed of three members. The members will be selected from former staff employees, now retired, from the Defense Department, the DCI area, and the FBI.
- C. The membership will be appointed for a period of four months. In this period, it will meet often enough to accomplish its task and report its findings to the DCI by 7 October 1983.
- D. Staff support to the Commission will be provided by the Community Counterintelligence Staff (CCIS).
