Soviet Involvement in the Peace Movement (S)

Thank you for the several reports on the Soviet involvement in the peace movement which you have forwarded to the President. As you know, he remains extremely interested in this question. It would be helpful to him if you could pull together the large amount of information and analysis on this subject into a detailed and comprehensive written briefing on the evidence which indicates such involvement. You should, therefore, prepare a five to ten page classified paper, drawing on all available sources, which details the extent and degree of success of Soviet active measures directed toward the peace movement. This report would be for my use and the President's and would not receive wider dissemination, nor would it become the subject of public comment. (TS)

It is requested that this paper be comprehensive, educative, and detailed. In this regard, please also include an overview concerning Soviet Active Measures so this phenonema can be put into perspective. This should include your assessment of the purpose, target, scope, technique and effectiveness of these activities. I am similarly asking Director Webster for an assessment of specific Soviet efforts within the US. (S)
