

MISSION READOUT: THE NORTHERN MOST PONTON BRIDGE AT 30-49-10N 032-19-06E WAS AN EGYPTIAN UNIFLOTE BRIDGE CROSSING THE CANAL 14 NAUTICAL MILES (NM) NORTH OF ISMAILIA. ONE EMPTY CARGO TRUCK WAS ON THE BRIDGE HEADING EAST. ONE TRUCK, ONE AT-T (ARTILLERY TRACKED PRIME MOVER), 10 CARGO TRUCKS AND FOUR JEEPS WERE NEAR THE EASTERN END OF THE BRIDGE. NINE TRUCKS, ONE BULLDOZER AND EIGHT JEEPS WERE NEAR THE WESTERN END OF THE BRIDGE. (NOT ALL VEHICLES ARE SHOWN ON GRAPHIC). TWO FLOATING PIPELINES CROSSED THE CANAL IN THIS AREA, ONE ON EITHER SIDE OF THE PONTON BRIDGE. THE PIPELINE ON THE SOUTH SIDE

THE SECOND EGYPTIAN BRIDGE AT 30-40-50N 031-20-30E WAS A PMP-TYPE PONTON BRIDGE CROSSING THE CANAL 6.5 NM NORTH OF ISMAILIA. A TOTAL OF FIVE TRUCKS WERE ON THE APPROACHES TO THE BRIDGE. ONE PIPELINE CROSSED THE CANAL JUST NORTH OF THIS PMP PONTON BRIDGE.


