
SUBJECT : Army Follow-up of DCI [redacted]

1. Attached is a memorandum from General Odom commenting on six issues identified for follow-up [redacted] Particularly notable is paragraph 3 in which General Odom expresses considerable pessimism about the prospects for [redacted]

2. The acronym "EUDAC" in paragraph 4 refers to the European Defense Analysis Center. General Odom's remarks reflect long-standing uncertainties about the very question you raised: how do we envision ELINT management in wartime? [redacted]

[redacted] Personally, I would have to take some exception to General Odom's assessment of "minimal" impact on the Army if EUDAC "disappeared." Some arrangement must be made for the integration and analysis of ELINT data at the theater level in wartime. [redacted]
