

PROBABLE 39TH ARMY COMMAND POST DEPLOYMENT

- 1. **SIGNIFICANCE:** A PROBABLE 39TH ARMY COMMAND POST EXERCISE WAS OBSERVED FOR THE FIRST TIME IN MONGOLIA. (SWN) [Redacted]

- 2. **REMARKS:** THE BUUTERIN HURAL ALERT DEPLOYMENT AREA CONSISTED OF A COMBAT CONTROL CENTER, A STAFF OPERATIONS CENTER, A RADIO RECEIVER CENTER, A COMMAND POST BUNKER AND ELEMENTS OF A FORWARD COMMAND POST (GRAPHIC 1). A COMMUNICATIONS CENTER WAS 300 METERS NORTH OF THE MAIN DEPLOYMENT AREA (GRAPHIC 2). SIGNATURE EQUIPMENT INCLUDED BABOCHKA EXPANDABLE VANS, A PROBABLE KH-1 COMPUTER VAN COMMUNICATIONS CENTER ASSOCIATED VANS, A PARK DRIVE, THREE TWIN EAR A (NOT DEPICTED ON GRAPHIC), AND FIELD OPERATION VAN SETS (FOV). (SWN)

ANALYST'S COMMENTS -- THE NUMBER OF BABOCHKA EXPANDABLE VANS (6) IN THE COMBAT CONTROL CENTER AND THE RELATIVELY SMALL SIZE OF THE COMMUNICATIONS CENTER IDENTIFIES THIS AS AN ARMY-LEVEL FIELD COMMAND POST. ALERT DEPLOYMENT AREAS SERVE AS COMMAND POST TRAINING AREAS IN PEACETIME, AND MAY HAVE A COMMAND AND CONTROL FUNCTION DURING ACTUAL MOBILIZATION OPERATIONS. THE FORWARD COMMAND POST MAY BE OPERATIONALLY DEPLOYED 12 TO 25 NM FROM THE MAIN COMMAND POST DURING WARTIME. (SWN)
