FIGHTING CONTINUES IN THE CENTRAL SECTOR OF THE SYRIAN FRONT. A COMBINED SYRIAN AND IRAGI FORCE ATTACKED ISRAELI POSITIONS AT DAWN ON 16 OCTOBER, RESULTING IN HEAVY TANK BATTLES NEAR AL HARRAH. 


