Reducing 2–4% with H₂ and 5% Pd-C in EtOH, filtering, evap., and wash. with HCl gas gives 1.2 g. 2-*N*-CH₃CH₂NCH₂CH₂Ph·HCl (V), *m.* 269°, *mp.* 269°.

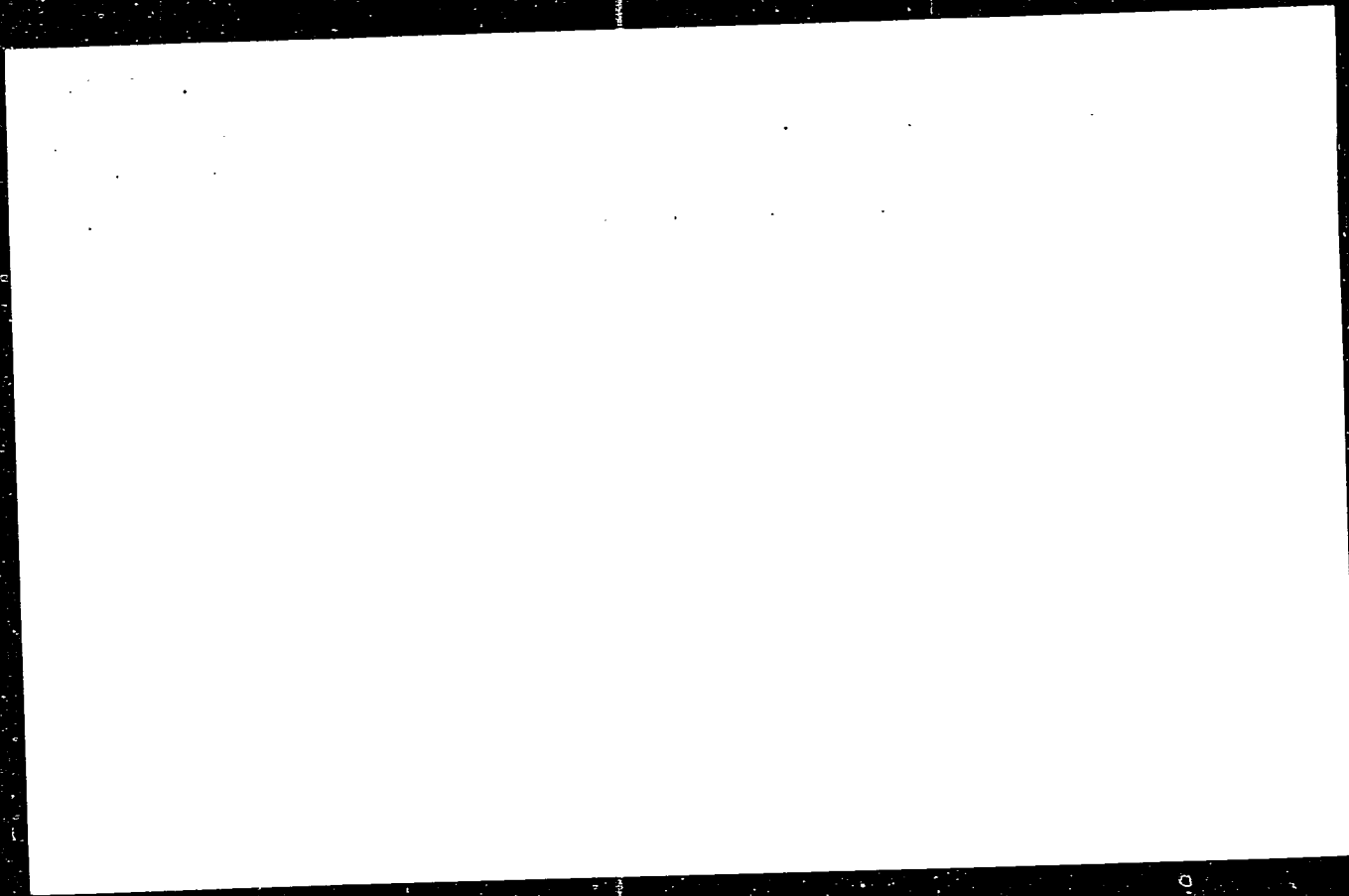

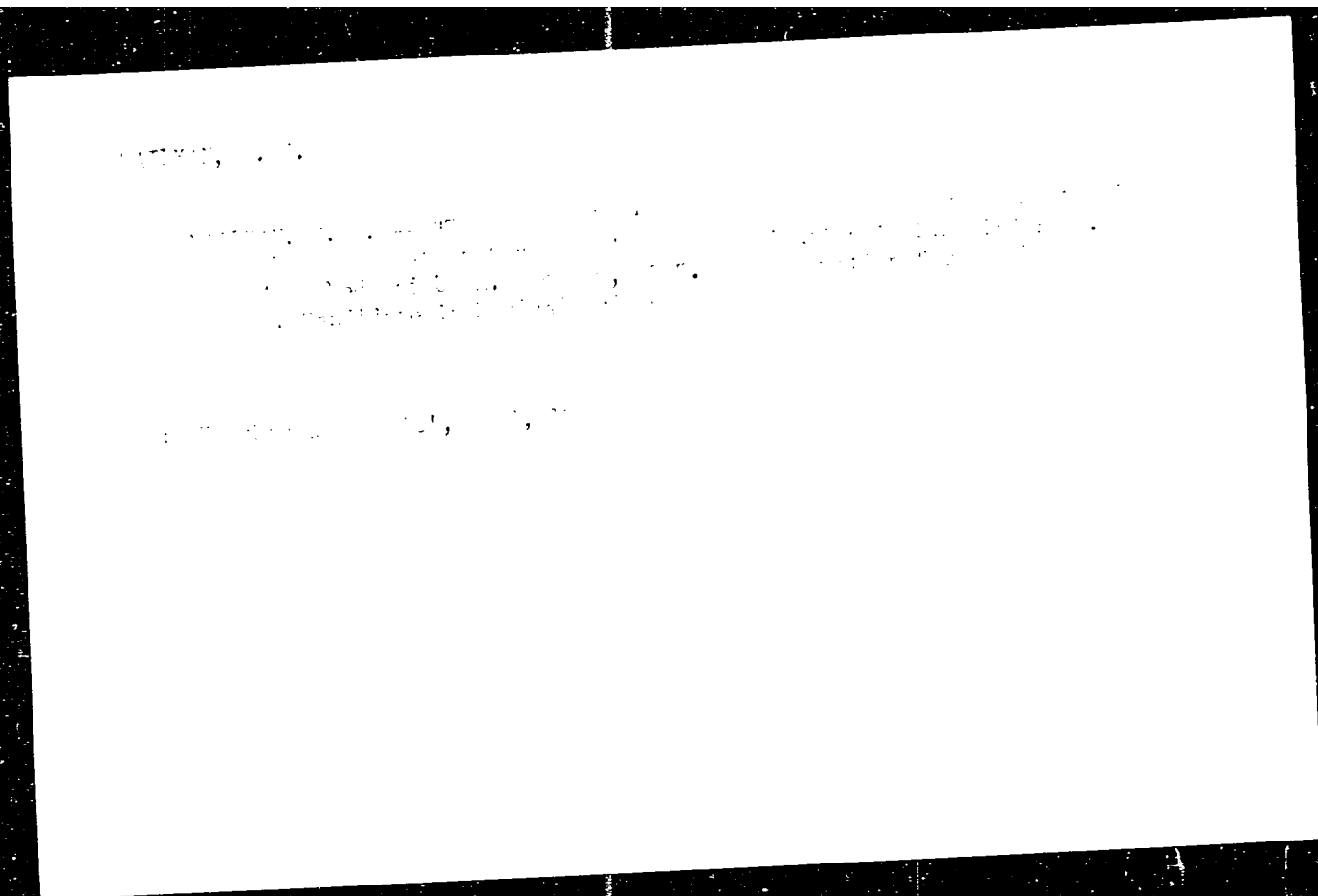
