2. NFAC's Office of Central Reference assembled about "9 inches" of material on several manufacturing plants in the USSR where some reporting suggested Oswald may have been employed. This material was made available to HSCA Staff (Cornwell) on 16 October 1978. OCR is extracting this material from its regular files and we make it available to you for storage under whatever regimen is agreed with HSCA. [redacted]
