MEMORANDUM FOR: Executive Officer to the

SUBJECT : Request for Rezoning Application B-763
as Indicated in Letter dated 5 December
1967 to CIA from Director of Planning,
Fairfax County, Virginia

1. The one acre property for which change in zoning is being requested is located on the south side of Route 193 or "Georgetown Pike" just east of the intersection with "Old Route 123." A service station has for a long period been located on it; so it is a "nonconforming" property. Adjacent properties are zoned "one family residential" with a minimum size of one acre. The owners have not indicated to the Director of Planning what "commercial" use is intended, but the application, if approved, would permit construction of a larger service station or perhaps a group of small shops or stores, etc.

2. It is more than one-half mile from this property to our site entrance on Route 123 and somewhat further to the nearest part of the Headquarters Building which is screened by hills and woods. It is recommended that the attached letter (indicating no comments) be sent to Mr. John Yaremchuk.

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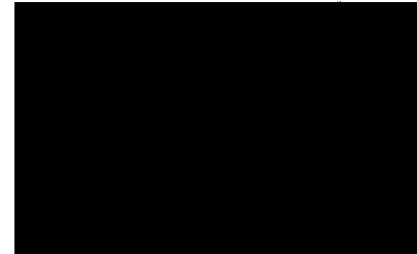
