SUBJECT: PFIAB

1. We promised that we would seek to make our meetings with the PFIAB problem-sharing ones. To follow through on this, I think we should review the meetings to date with this board, what has been set in motion or accomplished, what they have recommended to the President as far as we know, what directives have emanated from their initiatives, and what responses have been made to those directives. Ones that come to mind are subjects on which high interest has been expressed like Mexico, the Soviet economy, and maybe one or two others.

2. I think yesterday's meeting on the NRU and expressions by each side of appreciation for the cooperation and contributions supplied by the other may lay the basis for focusing future efforts of PFIAB and our responses in an increasingly more productive direction.
