1. Subject concept has merit and could significantly improve the DA's ability to respond to unforeseen "crash" requirements. [Redacted]

2. The list of factors appears complete with one exception. It is recommended that training be added as a factor both in the broad sense; i.e., OTE, and specifically as it affects a given office. For instance, should an unforeseen activity involve the use of unfamiliar equipments or methodologies, OC might be required to take extraordinary measures to obtain the needed training. [Redacted]
