1. Critical Technologies Required by the IC, 1985-1995 [redacted]

[redacted] of the IC Staff presented the draft results of the Critical Technologies Panel to determine critical technologies required by the Intelligence Community through 1995. [redacted]

2. Collection Against Foreign Satellites* [redacted]
