Bill Schneider, Under Secretary of State, called to ask for a paper from us on the issue of whether the United States should resume its support to the [Redacted]

[Redacted] You will recall that the support was terminated on the basis that in our judgment it was being used as a Soviet instrumentality. On the other hand, I understand that it has some potential value for us. The issue comes up because McGeorge Bundy and other academics are writing letters to Shultz to reverse the decision to discontinue support. Schneider would like to have a current intelligence assessment as the basis for advising the Secretary.
