- 2. Items/events of interest:
- a. On 14 September, the Director of Personnel (D/OP) briefed the Executive Committee regarding the Office of Personnel's activity toward developing a supplemental retirement program for Agency employees hired after 31 December 1983. The presentation included an update on Congressional and Administrative activity relative to supplemental retirement and the present retirement system. In conjunction with consultants, OP is preparing a specific retirement plan to present to the Executive Committee.
- b. Chief, Retirement Division/OP attended a mark-up session held by the House Subcommittee on Compensation and Employee Benefits regarding H.R. 2300, Civil Service Retirement and Spousal Legislation. If passed, substantial changes would provide new options and benefits to certain former spouses of civil service employees. There are strong indications that some form of this legislation will be passed prior to Congressional adjournment for the elections.

c. The Office of Communications (OC) is providing the Department of
the Army with three satellite earth terminals and associated equipment
Payback funds totaling \$4.3 million are
being transferred to OC from the Department of the Army to cover the
