Benefits

Surgical Schedule allowance under High Option liberalized for 12 different surgical procedures.


The Major Medical maximum amount payable is increased from \$10,000.00 to \$20,000.00.

Double Coverage provision now permits a covered person to receive up to 100 percent of total covered expenses. (Both Options)

Definition of a doctor has been expanded to include licensed Dental Surgeons and Podiatrists for certain services. (Both Options)

Rates

Low Option remains the same. Rates for High Option will increase. The increase in the High Option, biweekly cost, will be 97 cents for self only enrollment and 68 cents for a self and family enrollment.
