NIO/AL(Hans Heymann) attended a dinner discussion at the Carnegie Endowment on "US Foreign Policy in the 1980s" with Robert Lieber (Georgetown University), William Schneider (AEI), and Steve Van Evera (Princeton) as lead panelists.

NIO/AL(Hans Heymann) met with Herman Kahn (Hudson Institute) to discuss their concept of "The Great Transition." Kahn believes that all the indicators point to a US in the early stages of a massive economic revitalization with high growth rates lasting for the next 15-20 years.
