MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: 10 December Briefing of the Task Force for Intelligence Activities.

1. Colonel Lane remarked early in the day that the remainder of the Far East Division would be relatively easy to cover, due to the excellent briefing the day before by [REDACTED]. The major part of the day was spent in walking from office to office meeting the large number of FE personnel. 25X1A9a

2. Colonel Lane continued, much as the day before, the same recurrent questioning on [REDACTED] efforts, requirements, training and personnel. With regard to organization, at one point Colonel Lane remarked, "I am not going to criticize any branch organizational structure. If it suits your purposes and has the approval of the Agency its O. K. with me."

3. Early in the afternoon Colonel Lane showed signs of weariness and as the walking continued he stated that he was getting tired; thus the last two branches were somewhat glossed over and we ended the day at approximately 1615 hours.
