1. Approval is requested to reprogram [] within the CRAFT Program to provide for the development of a Data Encryption System. A feasibility study to determine the best technical alternatives was completed in January 1984. Based on the technical alternative chosen, cost estimates for the development of a prototype system have been projected at [] with an additional [] required for [] [] that will be required for the production units. The Office of Security and the Office of Communications have agreed to share in the total cost of [] million as indicated below:
