

Time Names New General Manager

NEW YORK (AP) — A 29-year-old Harvard graduate was named general manager of Time magazine yesterday. Kelso Sutton, named by Time publisher James R. Shepley, has been business manager. He succeeds James A. Thompson, who retired last month. John Keller, also 29, was named to replace Sutton. He was assistant business manager. Sutton, who joined Time in 1961 after graduation, lives in Manhattan. Keller, a 1961 Yale graduate and a 1963 graduate of the Harvard Business School, lives in New Canaan, Conn.
