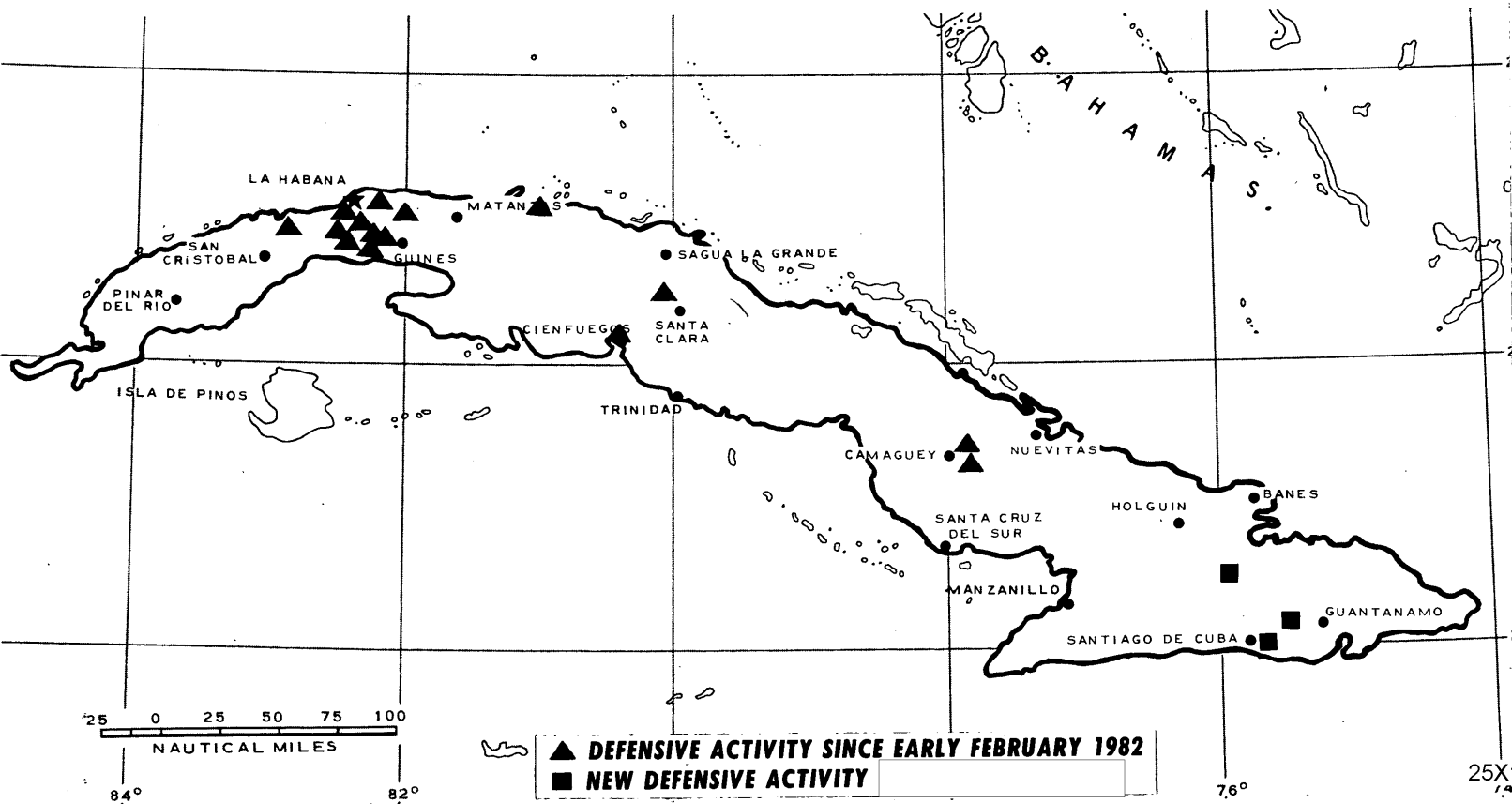

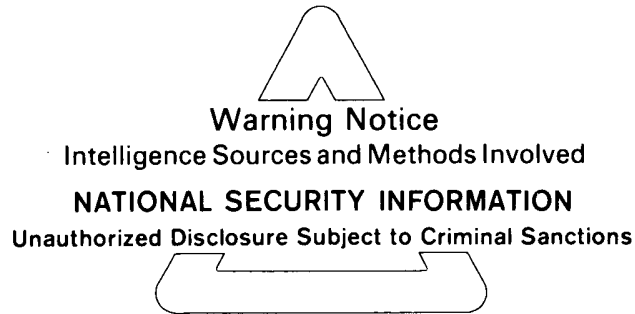

1. (S/D) SIGNIFICANCE: INCREASED DEFENSIVE MEASURES ARE OBSERVED IN EASTERN CUBA AT OFELIA MILITARY CAMP A HQ [Redacted] SABANA MILITARY CAMP A HQ [Redacted] AND AT SIBONEY AW RADAR FAC [Redacted] DEFENSIVE ACTIVITY HAS NOW BEEN OBSERVED AT 18 LOCATIONS IN CUBA SINCE EARLY FEBRUARY 1982.

2. (S/D) REMARKS: AT OFELIA MILITARY CAMP A HQ [Redacted] THE CUBAN EASTERN ARMY INDEPENDENT ARTILLERY BRIGADE HAS DEPLOYED FROM ITS GARRISON PARKING AREA TO TACTICAL VEHICLE REVETMENTS (GRAPHIC 2 OF 4). THE DEPLOYED EQUIPMENT IS BEING CAMOUFLAGED. ONE ARTILLERY BATTALION (BN) IS DEPLOYED 0.5 NM NORTH OF THE INSTALLATION IN REVETMENTS WHICH HAVE BEEN CONSTRUCTED SINCE [Redacted] THE DEPLOYMENT AREA INCLUDES TWO LARGE COMMAND POST/PERSONNEL BUNKERS INTO WHICH CONCRETE REINFORCING STRUCTURES ARE BEING PLACED, AND APPROXIMATELY 50 VEHICLE REVETMENTS. EQUIPMENT IN THIS AREA INCLUDES TEN 130MM FIELD GUNS M-46, 14 AT-P ARMORED TRACKED ARTILLERY TRACTORS, SEVEN AT-S MEDIUM TRACKED ARTILLERY TRACTORS, AND 18 PIECES OF SUPPORT EQUIPMENT. A SECOND ARTILLERY BN DEPLOYMENT AREA IS ON THE WEST EDGE OF THE INSTALLATION (NOT ON GRAPHIC). TACTICALLY DISPERSED, BUT NOT REVETTED, AND IN SOME CASES CAMOUFLAGED, EQUIPMENT IN THE AREA INCLUDES ONE LARGE TENT, EIGHT 130MM FIELD GUNS M-46, AND 12 AT-P ARMORED TRACKED ARTILLERY TRACTORS. A THIRD ARTILLERY BN (NOT ON GRAPHIC) IS DEPLOYED IN REVETMENTS WITHIN A HEAVILY WOODED AREA NEAR THE CENTER OF THE INSTALLATION. EQUIPMENT IN THIS AREA, SOME OF WHICH WAS PRESENT [Redacted] INCLUDES EIGHT AT-P ARMORED TRACKED ARTILLERY TRACTORS. IN ADDITION, FOUR LIGHT ANTI-AIRCRAFT ARTILLERY POSITIONS AROUND THE PERIMETER OF THE INSTALLATION ARE OCCUPIED. A FIFTH POSITION, INSIDE THE INSTALLATION, HAS BEEN VACATED SINCE [Redacted]

(S/D) AT SABANA MILITARY CAMP A HQS [REDACTED], ELEMENTS OF TWO PROBABLE ANTITANK BN, ONE TANK, SIX ARMORED VEHICLES, AND AT LEAST 35 OTHER TRUCKS ARE DISPERSED IN REVETMENTS OUTSIDE THE NORTHERN PERIMETER OF THE INSTALLATION (GRAPHIC 3 OF 4). MOST OF THE EQUIPMENT (NOT ALL ON GRAPHIC) IS EITHER HEAVILY CAMOUFLAGED OR CANVAS DRAPED. SIX UNIDENTIFIED OBJECTS ARE UNDER CANVAS IN ARTILLERY REVETMENTS IN THE WESTERN SECTION OF THE INSTALLATION. FIVE OCCUPIED SIX-POSITION ANTI-AIRCRAFT ARTILLERY SITES ARE ALSO PRESENT AROUND THE INSTALLATION.

(S/D) AT SIBONEY AW RADAR FACILITY [REDACTED], DEFENSIVE REVETMENTS HAVE BEEN CONSTRUCTED SINCE AT LEAST [REDACTED] (GRAPHIC 4 OF 4). AT LEAST 16 REVETMENTS ARE NORTH OF THE FACILITY, 11 TO THE WEST, AND AT LEAST FIVE TO THE SOUTH. IN ADDITION, FOXHOLES AND A DEFENSIVE TRENCH HAVE BEEN DUG WITHIN THE FACILITY.

(S/D) OTHER AREAS (GRAPHIC 1 OF 4) WHERE SIMILAR ACTIVITY HAS BEEN OBSERVED INCLUDE THE AIRFIELDS AT IGNACION AGRAMONTE [REDACTED] PLAYA BARACOA [REDACTED] SAN ANTONIO DE LOS BANOS [REDACTED] AND SAN PEDRO [REDACTED]; THE GROUND FORCES INSTALLATIONS AT CARDENAS [REDACTED] LA HABANA-GUANABACOA [REDACTED], MANAGUA [REDACTED] AND SANTIAGO DE LOS VEGAS [REDACTED]; THE NAVAL FACILITIES AT CABANAS [REDACTED] AND CIENFUEGOS [REDACTED] THE RADAR FACILITY AT LA HABANA [REDACTED] AND THE SURFACE-TO-AIR MISSILE SITES AT CAMAGUEY [REDACTED] AND SANTA CLARA [REDACTED]

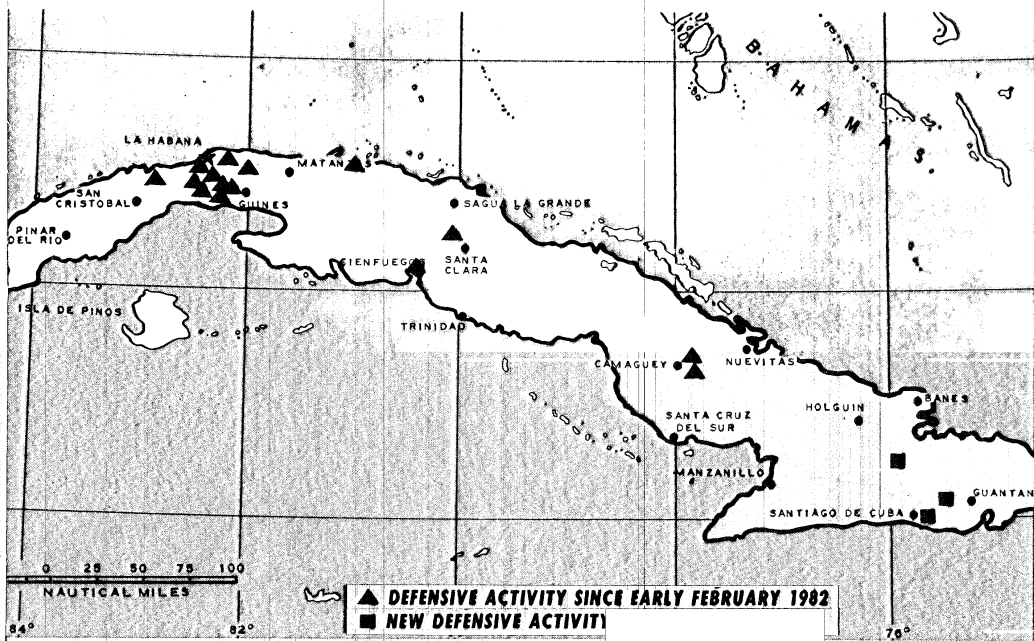
