4. The training throughout the eight weeks, with the exception of a Marxism/Leninism segment, received high evaluations from the students. The training segments included an overview of the Agency, Marxism/Leninism, Priority Issues, the Intelligence Community, Interpersonal Communications Skills, Operations Familiarization, and the Agency culture. The students especially enjoyed their stay at our primary training recommendations for next years' program are listed below:
