2. Dr. Colvard's appointment as Deputy Director of the Office of Personnel Management was confirmed by the Senate on 15 August 1986. Since 1985, Dr. Colvard had been Director, Civilian Personnel Policy, Department of the Navy. It was in 1985 that he was selected to receive the Presidential Distinguished Executive Rank Award from President Reagan (this award is the SES equivalent of our Distinguished Officer Stipend). Dr. Colvard served as Deputy Chief, Navy Material Command from 1980 to 1985. He has been affiliated with the Naval Weapons Laboratory in Dahlgren, Virginia, where he managed the Navy's electronic warfare research and development program from 1969 to 1971. He served as Technical Director of the Laboratory in 1973 and also served as Technical Director of the Naval Surface Weapons Center at the Laboratory in 1974.

3. Dr. Colvard graduated from Berea College (B.A., 1958), the University of Oklahoma (M.A., 1973), and the University of Southern California (Ph.D., 1982).
