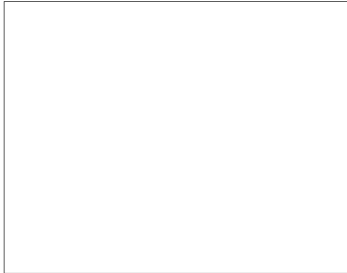

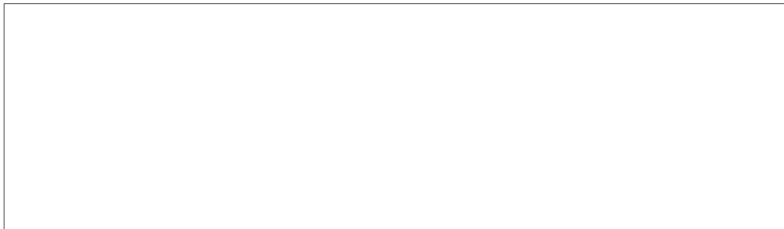
Defector Hearings: Third Day's Statements
