Mr. Mulvenna, Manager of the Network Applications Group at the NBS Institute for Computer Science and Technology (ICST), briefed on the International Standards Organization model for Open Systems Interconnection (OSI) and described the function of the NBS in bringing about implementation of Government Open Systems Interconnection Profile (GOSIP) as a federal information processing standard. GOSIP is dedicated to reducing technical barriers to interoperability among government information systems and improving the availability of commercial off-the-shelf technology.

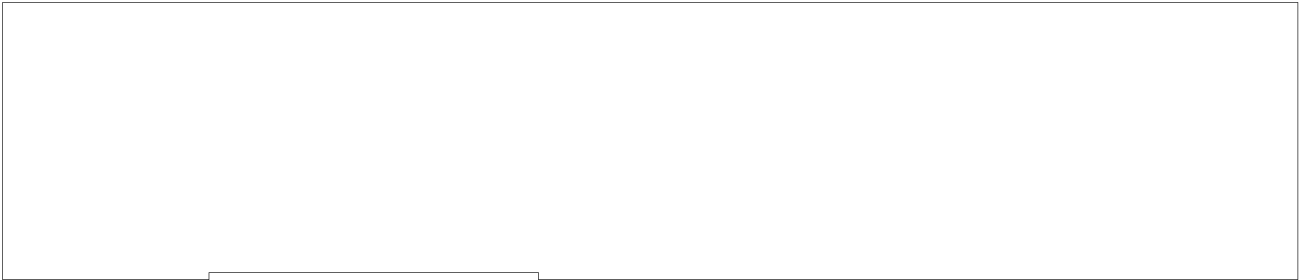
25X1 b. On 17 November, Messrs. [REDACTED]

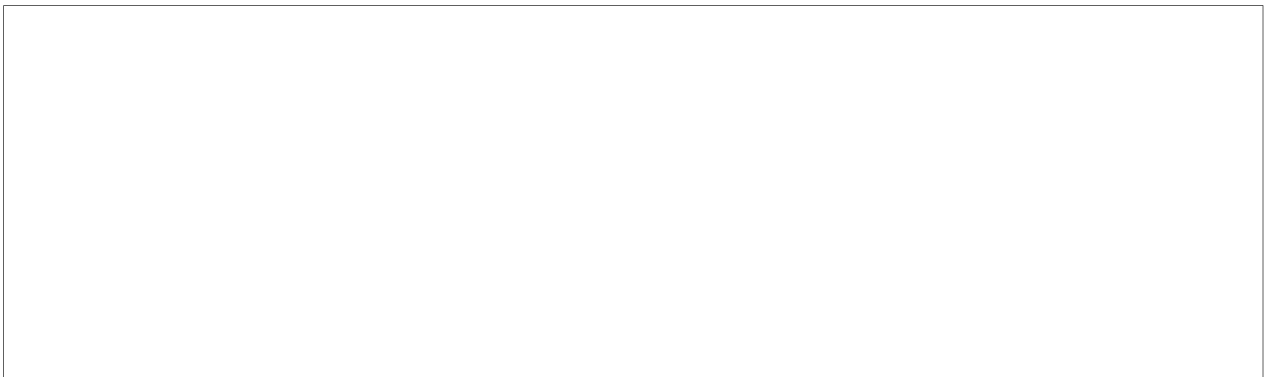

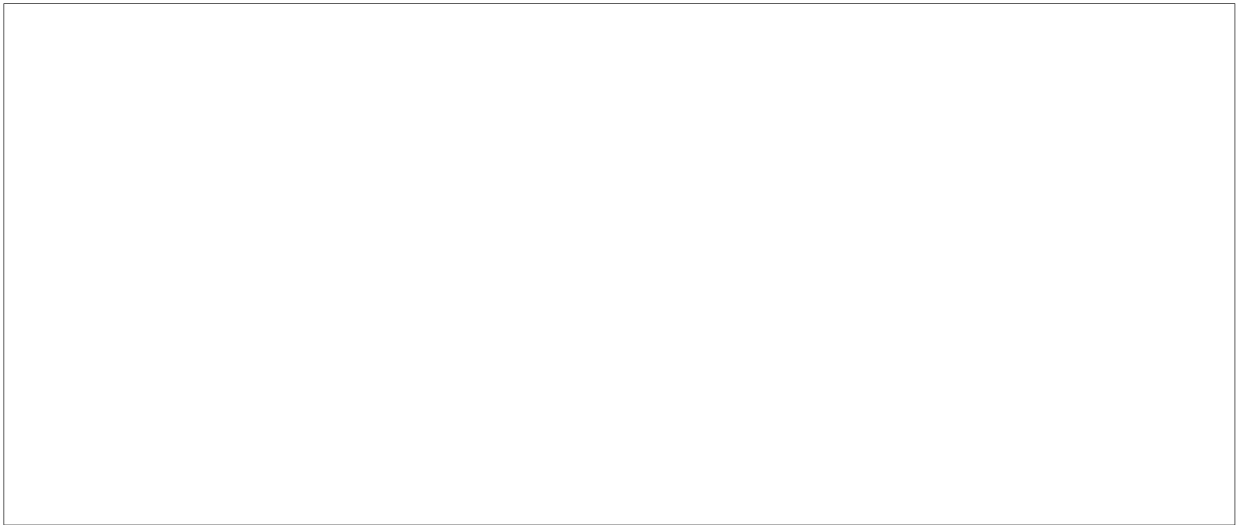

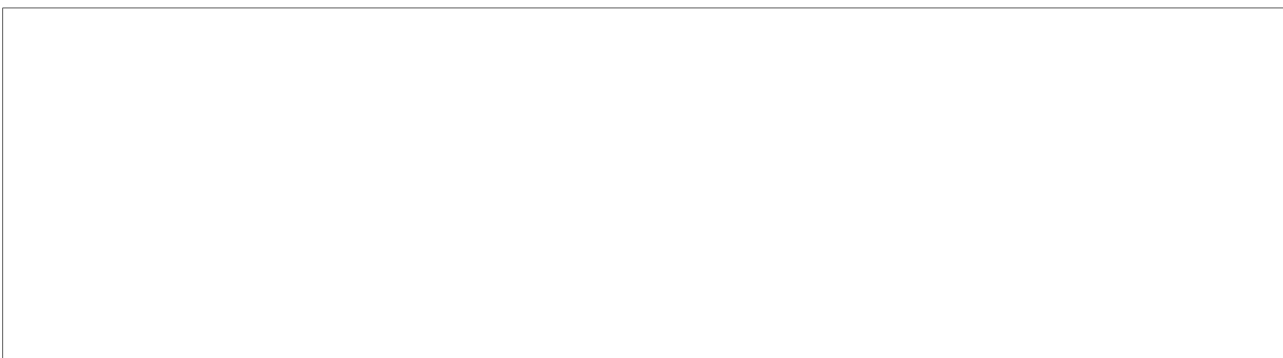
