(1) Renovations - Bid opening for the renovation of South, East, and Central Buildings was held on 7 September 1988. The low bidder was Suburban Contractors, Inc. of Vienna, VA with a bid of \$362,300.00. Renovation activities at the site are expected to commence within 10-14 days.

(2) Asbestos Survey - Asbestos surveys of South, East, and Central Buildings began on 9 September 1988. The survey of Central Building is priority one and should be completed by 15 September 1988, followed by surveys of the remaining two structures. Once estimated cost for abatement/removal has been determined, the information will be provided to General Services Administration (GSA). GSA has agreed to provide funding for any required work. Field Engineering Branch engineers will continue to assist GSA as required to ensure all abatement and removal activities are accomplished per federal guidelines.

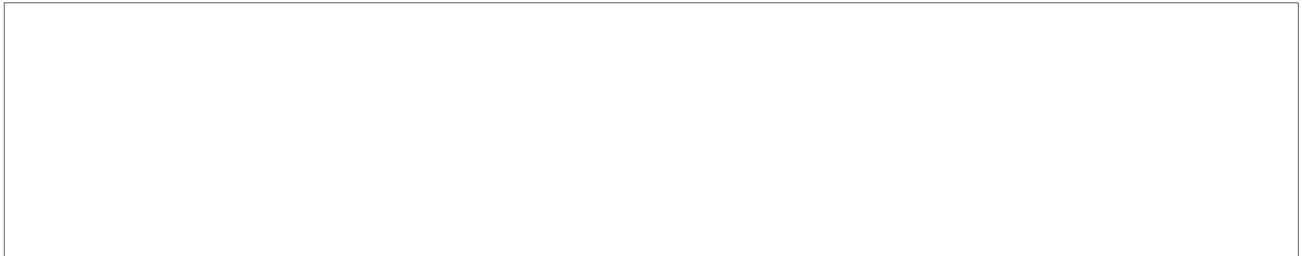

EBOB is gathering requirements in order to complete the design.

(4) Chamber of Commerce - The final set of drawings for a new guard station at Chamber of Commerce Building have been approved by SESD and given to Dominion Management for a cost estimate. OTE has obligated \$12K of FY-88 funds to cover this project.
