## War crimes suspect, CIA allegedly linked

Renewed allegations that the Central Intelligence Agency misled Congress by slipping Nazi collaborators into the United States surfaced this week when a New York man was identified as a possible war criminal who aided the agency in intelligence operations. A report by the General Accounting Office indicates that Mykola Lebed provided intelligence information to the CIA and that he was brought into the country under an alias. John Loftus, a Rockland, Mass., lawyer and former Justice

Department investigator, says Lebed, 75, a Ukranian emigre, is "arguably the highest-ranking Nazi criminal or collaborator still at large." Loftus is working with Congress and the GAO on such cases. (Globe Staff)
