SUBJECT: Full Senate Debate on ASAT

1. On 12 June 1984 at 1:00 p.m., Larry Gershwin, National Intelligence Office for Strategic Programs, attended Hearing of the Full Senate on the Soviet Space and ASAT Programs as the Intelligence Community's technical referent. During the debate, technical questions were asked of Dr. Gershwin by Senator Warner, who presented the briefing, and Senators Wallop and Moynihan of the SSCI who were active participants in the discussion. Dr. Gershwin answered their questions privately and did not speak directly to the Senate. Senators came and went during the 1 1/2 hour session, but at least 50 were present throughout. Debate centered, as it did in open session, on Soviet ASAT capabilities and US ability to monitor even a partial ASAT treaty.
