SUMMARY: Re Letter of 15 August 1984 from Senator Symms. A series of misunderstandings resulted in no response being given to OLL for transmittal to Senator Symms' Boise office.

I called Marsha Hall to apologize for the lack of response, stating I had been away on leave and the letter was apparently overlooked. Marsha accepted my explanation, had no problems with the delay, and then stated [redacted] a cousin of the deceased is the individual who is inquiring about a medal he believes [redacted] received from the CIA. [redacted] father (Marsha believes to be brother of [redacted] mother) was told by [redacted] father that [redacted] was employed by CIA. [redacted] and his father are not sure of this, but are interested in a medal that was mentioned being awarded to [redacted]

I explained to Marsha that I was having old files searched to determine what information we might have on subject, and also emphasized that perhaps I would not be able to confirm or deny [redacted] affiliation. She also understood this position and will await hearing from us.

NOTE: A previous request was received in 1983 from stepfather of subject, [redacted]
