

Dear Mr. Webster:

Please supply me, as a member of the Defense Appropriations Subcommittee, with the following information by close of business September 29, 1988.

- I. A listing, by time of flight and distance, of all Soviet ballistic missile tests which would have violated the restriction defined in the Nagle Amendment to the FY 89 Defense Authorization Bill, printed in the Congressional Record May 11, 1988. In order to hold down the classification level, this list should not include date of test or missile type.
  - II. A list of the total number of such tests, broken down by missile type.
- III. In order to hold the classification to the lowest possible level, a line chart with horizontal axis denoting distance of flight and vertical axis denoting time of flight, with the line indicating the flight tests from list I above with quickest time-for-distance.

I recognize that I am asking for a quick response, but the Defense Appropriations Sub-committee may find itself needing this information urgently as the conference progresses. As you know, CPA previously assembled the basic information for the Defense Authorization Conference.
