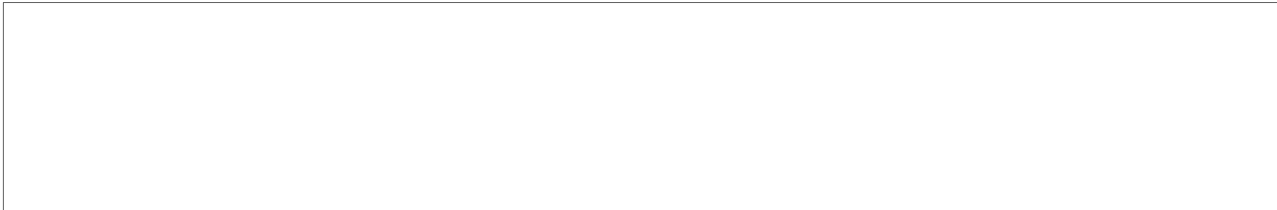

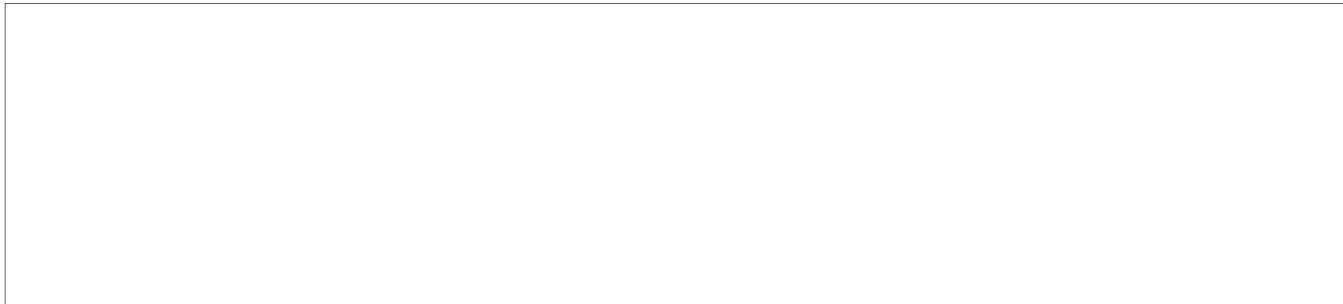
OEA briefed the outgoing JUSMAG, Gen. Teeter, on political and economic developments in the Philippines.

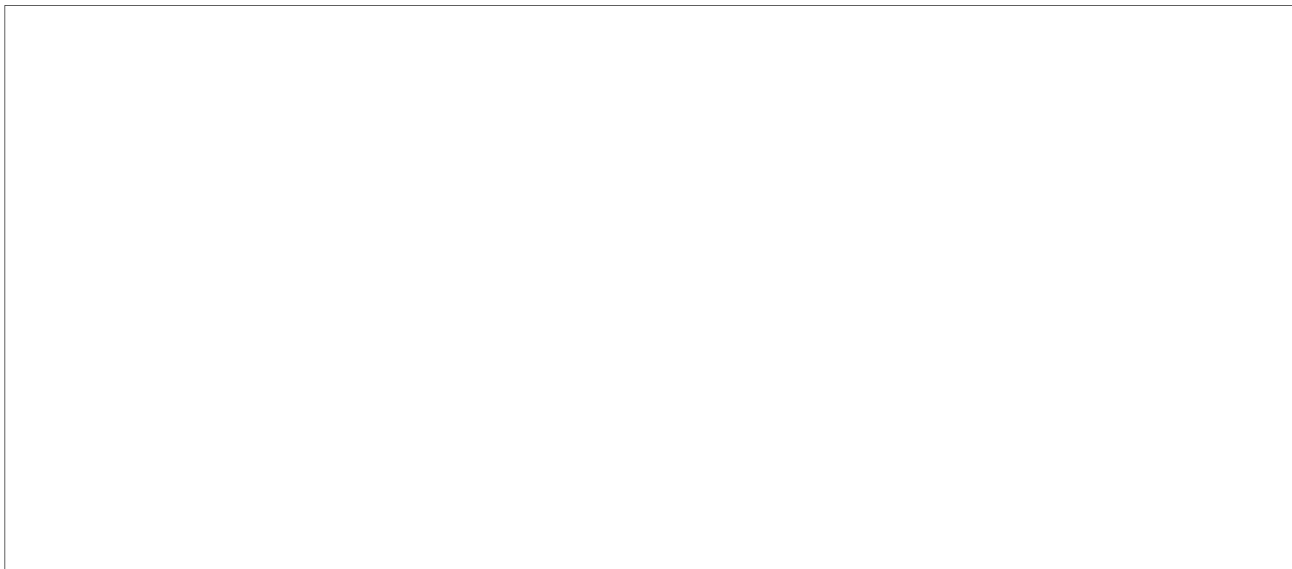

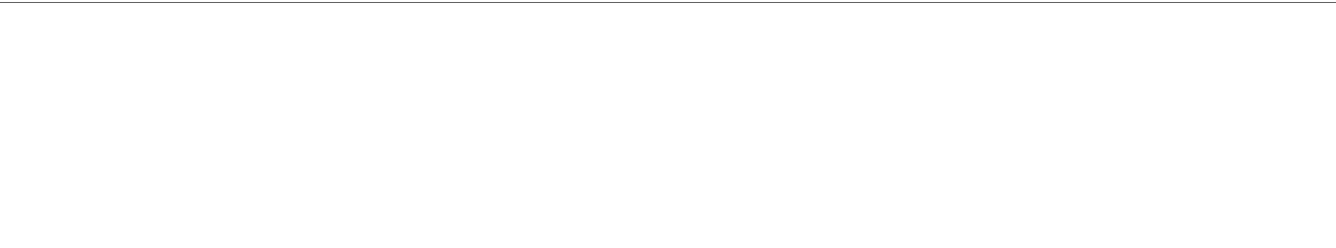

OSWR secretaries attended a 2-day seminar, "To See Ourselves Better," conducted by Clemson University in Harper's Ferry, West Virginia.

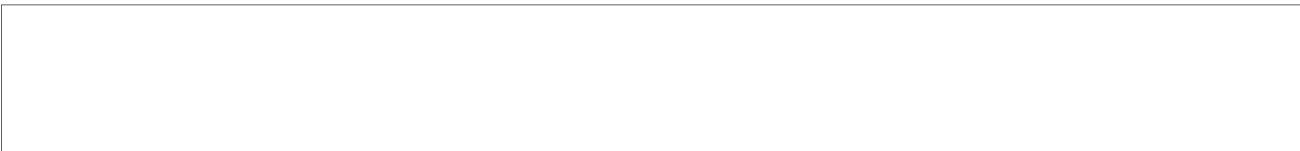

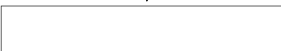
SOVA sponsored a conference at Airlie House on political-military relations under Gorbachev.
