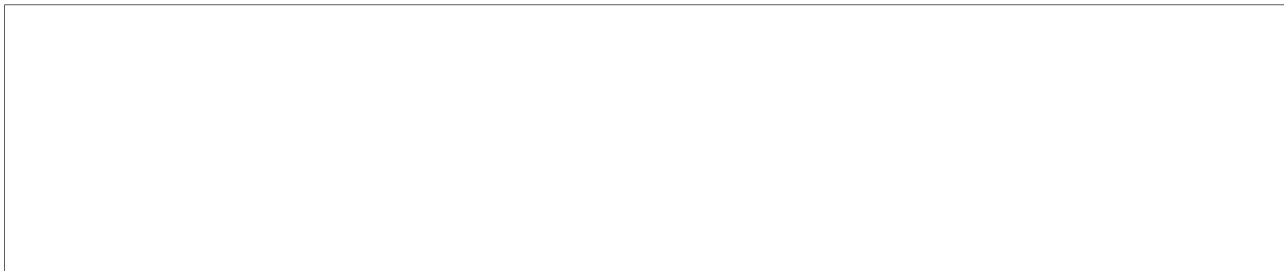

2. According to Mr. Olin, the briefing was being held because Senator Chiles and other Senators were interested in developing anti-narcotics legislation in this session. He said that Senator Chiles wants a briefing on the same topic at a later date. [redacted]

3. [redacted] briefed Olin on annual narcotics production in Latin America and South and Southeast Asia. They provided comparative estimates of the last two years production. The main conclusion was that production was increasing in the select countries despite some eradication efforts. [redacted]
