1. (SWN) SIGNIFICANCE: A LARGE AIRCRAFT DISPLAY, PROBABLY RELATED TO THE MEETING OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY (OAU) TO BE HELD IN TARABULUS, LIBYA BETWEEN [REDACTED] IS OBSERVED HERE.

2. (SWN) REMARKS: IN ADDITION TO THE AIRCRAFT DISPLAY, A REVIEWING AREA, TROOP FORMATION, AND MOTORCADE ARE PRESENT.

(SWN) AIRCRAFT IN THE DISPLAY NOT USUALLY AT UMM AITIOAH AIRFIELD INCLUDE 16 FLOGGER, FOUR SUPER FRELON (NOT ON GRAPHIC), AND TWO PROBABLE HAZE A (NOT ON GRAPHIC). THE FLOGGER PROBABLY CAME FROM BENINA AIRFIELD [REDACTED] WHERE A DECREASE IN FLOGGER HAS OCCURRED SINCE [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] OTHER AIRCRAFT IN THE DISPLAY INCLUDE FIVE CANDID, 23 FOXBAT, 15 L-39, AND NINE MIRAGE III/V.

(SWN) AIRCRAFT ON THE TRANSIENT APRON, PROBABLY NOT ASSOCIATED WITH THE DISPLAY ARE TWO BLINDER, ONE SOVIET CRUSTY, ONE JETSTAR, ONE FAN JET FALCON 50, THREE C-130, ONE L-100 AND TWO CURL. TWELVE FITTER ARE PARKED ON THE TAXIWAY AT THE NORTHWEST END OF THE ESE/WNW RUNWAY. FITTER ARE NOT NORMALLY HERE.

(SWN) UMM AITIOAH AIRFIELD, 6 NM EAST OF TARABULUS, IS A MAJOR FIGHTER, BOMBER, AND TRANSPORT FIELD. BENINA AIRFIELD, 10 NM EAST OF BANGHAZI, IS A MAJOR FIGHTER BASE AND AIRCRAFT ASSEMBLY FACILITY.
