1. (SWN) SIGNIFICANCE: FOUR FOXBAT A HIGH ALTITUDE FIGHTER/INTERCEPTOR AIRCRAFT HAVE BEEN ARMED WITH ACRID (AA-6) AIR-TO-AIR MISSILES. LIBYAN FOXBAT NORMALLY ARE NOT OBSERVED ARMED.
2. (SWN) REMARKS: THREE OF THE ARMED FOXBAT ARE ON THE SOUTH PARKING APRON, AND THE FOURTH IS ON A HANGAR APRON AT THE EAST END OF THE AIRFIELD. THE REMAINING SEVEN FOXBAT PRESENT ARE DISPERSED IN NORMAL PARKING AREAS. THE 11 FOXBAT ARE PART OF AN ORIGINAL DEPLOYMENT OF 14 FOXBAT FIRST OBSERVED HERE ON [REDACTED] AN RSB-4N SHORT-RANGE NAVIGATIONAL SYSTEM HAS BEEN OPERATIONALLY DEPLOYED JUST SOUTH OF THE NORTHWEST/SOUTHEAST RUNWAY.
