1. (SWN) SIGNIFICANCE: ADDITIONAL SOVIET ARMS HAVE BEEN DELIVERED TO LIBYA.

2. (SWN) REMARKS: TWO FOUR-RAIL SA-3 LAUNCHERS, 18 ZSU-23/4 SELF-PROPELLED ANTIAIRCRAFT ARTILLERY GUNS (SPAA), ONE PROBABLE FLAT FACE RADAR (IN TRAVEL MODE), ONE PROBABLE SA-2/3 CANISTER TRANSPORTER, AND AT LEAST 30 VAN-BODIED TRUCKS/TRAILERS ARE ON THE MILITARY TRANSSHIPMENT QUAY. MOST OF THIS EQUIPMENT WAS PROBABLY PRESENT [REDACTED] BUT WAS NOT IDENTIFIABLE DUE TO IMAGE SCALE. THE OFFLOADING OF THIS EQUIPMENT FROM A SOVIET KAPITAN KUSHNARENKO-CLASS MERSHIP PROBABLY BEGAN ON [REDACTED] WHEN AT LEAST EIGHT TRUCKS AND TEN PROBABLE SMALL TRAILERS WERE ON THE QUAY. THE KAPITAN KUSHNARENKO-CLASS MERSHIP WAS FIRST OBSERVED AT THE QUAY [REDACTED]

(SWN) A SOVIET KAPITAN KUSHNARENKO-CLASS MERSHIP, THE 'KAPITAN SLIPKO', WAS REPORTED TO HAVE DEPARTED FROM THE BLACK SEA ON [REDACTED] WITH A DECK CARGO THAT INCLUDED THREE VAN BODIED TRUCKS, ONE STAKE TRUCK, ONE POSSIBLE RADAR VAN, FIVE AMBULANCES, TWO UTILITY VEHICLES, AND FOUR TRAILERS. THE 'KAPITAN SLIPKO' PREVIOUSLY CALLED AT TUBRUQ [REDACTED] THROUGH [REDACTED] AND BANGHAZI [REDACTED] IN LIBYA, (NFOIO SMA 212232Z DEC 82, SECRET [REDACTED])
