1. (SWN) SIGNIFICANCE: THE SOVIETS CONTINUE TO DELIVER MILITARY EQUIPMENT TO ETHIOPIA.

2. (SWN) REMARKS: NINE T-54/55 TANKS, THREE HEAVY LIFT TRANSPORTERS WITH PRIME MOVERS, 11 PROBABLE FIELD AMBULANCES, AND AT LEAST FIVE TRUCKS HAVE ARRIVED ON THE SOUTH MOLE SINCE [REDACTED] THIS EQUIPMENT WAS PROBABLY DELIVERED BY A SOVIET KAPITAN KUSHNARENKO-CLASS MERCHANT SHIP WHICH HAD ARRIVED AT ASEB [REDACTED] THE MERCHANT SHIP REMAINS AT THE SOUTH MOLE. THREE OF THE FORWARD HATCHES ON THE KAPITAN KUSHNARENKO ARE OPEN, AND THE UNLOADING OF ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT MAY BE IN PROGRESS. THE LAST OBSERVED SOVIET ARMS DELIVERY TO ASEB WAS [REDACTED]
