1. (SWN) SIGNIFICANCE: PROBABLE SA-5 LAUNCHERS ARE PRESENT, HOWEVER, THE SITE IS NOT YET OPERATIONAL.
2. (SWN) REMARKS: EIGHTEEN CANVAS-COVERED PROBABLE SA-5 SURFACE-TO-AIR (SAM) LAUNCHERS AND TWO SETS OF SQUARE PAIR ANTENNA TRAILERS ARE AT DUMAYR SA-5 COMPLEX. ONE PROBABLE LAUNCHER IS IN EACH OF THE 18 LAUNCH POSITIONS AT THE COMPLEX. THIS INCLUDES THE SIX LAUNCH POSITIONS IN THE NORTHEASTERN SITE WHERE THERE ARE ANOMALIES IN THE SITE CONSTRUCTION AND CONFIGURATION. THE SQUARE PAIR TRAILERS ARE IN ONE OF THE GUIDANCE AREAS AND NUMEROUS OTHER SUPPORT VEHICLES ARE IN THE OPERATIONS AND SUPPORT AREAS. THIS IS THE FIRST TIME SA-5 EQUIPMENT HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AT ONE OF THE TWO SA-5 COMPLEXES IN SYRIA. THE COMPLEX IS NOT YET OPERATIONAL, NO RADARS ARE SET-UP AT THE SITE AND THE PROBABLE LAUNCHERS ARE NOT CABLE CONNECTED.

(SWN) SA-5 MISSILE TRANSSHIPMENT ACTIVITY IS PROBABLY IN PROGRESS AT TARTUS PORT FACILITIES [REDACTED] TEN PROBABLE SA-5 MISSILE/CANISTER TRANSPORTERS (EIGHT CANVAS COVERED, EACH LOADED WITH A PROBABLE SA-5 MISSILE CANISTER AND ASSOCIATED FIN CRATES) ARE ON THE CENTRAL MOLE. TWO ADDITIONAL EMPTY SA-5 MISSILE/CANISTER TRANSPORTERS ARE NEAR A NEWLY ARRIVED SOVIET BEZITSA/POLTAVA-CLASS MERSHIP, INDICATING THAT AT LEAST TWO ADDITIONAL SA-5 CANISTERS WITH ASSOCIATED FIN CRATES MAY BE OFFLOADED SOON. A TOTAL OF 12 EMPTY SA-5 MISSILE/CANISTER TRANSPORTERS WERE ON THE MOLE [REDACTED] ONCE LOADED, THESE TRANSPORTERS WILL PROBABLY RETURN TO DAMASCUS SAM SUPPORT FACILITY 13 [REDACTED] WHERE THEY WERE LAST OBSERVED [REDACTED]

(SWN) ALSO AT TARTUS, AT LEAST THREE SA-8 SAM TRANSPORTER-ERECTOR-LAUNCHERS (TEL) AND AT LEAST ONE SA-8 RESUPPLY VEHICLE HAVE DEPARTED FROM THEIR DEPLOYED POSITIONS ON THE CENTRAL MOLE. SIX PROBABLE SA-8 TEL/RESUPPLY VEHICLES REMAIN DEPLOYED ON THE NORTH EDGE OF THE CENTRAL MOLE. THREE CANVAS-COVERED TRANSPORTERS (POSSIBLY MISSILE RELATED) ARE ON THE ROAD NEAR THE MILITARY TRANSSHIPMENT AREA.

(SWN) AT DAMASCUS SAM SUPPORT FACILITY 13, NO SIGNIFICANT CONSTRUCTION OR SA-5 ASSOCIATED ACTIVITY IS OBSERVED. SOME EQUIPMENT MOVEMENTS ARE EVIDENT IN THE INSTALLATION; HOWEVER, NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO THE NUMBERS OR TYPES OF EQUIPMENT ARE OBSERVED.

(SWN) AT AL LADHIQIYAH PORT FACILITIES [REDACTED] ONE KAPITAN KUSHNARENKO-CLASS MERSHIP REMAINS AT THE MAIN QUAY. NO ARMS TRANSSHIPMENT ACTIVITY IS OBSERVED. 25X1

(SWN) HIMS SA-5 COMPLEX [REDACTED] AND NIKOLAYEV PORT 25X1
FACILITIES SOUTH [REDACTED] IN THE SOVIET UNION ARE CLOUD COVERED. 25X1
