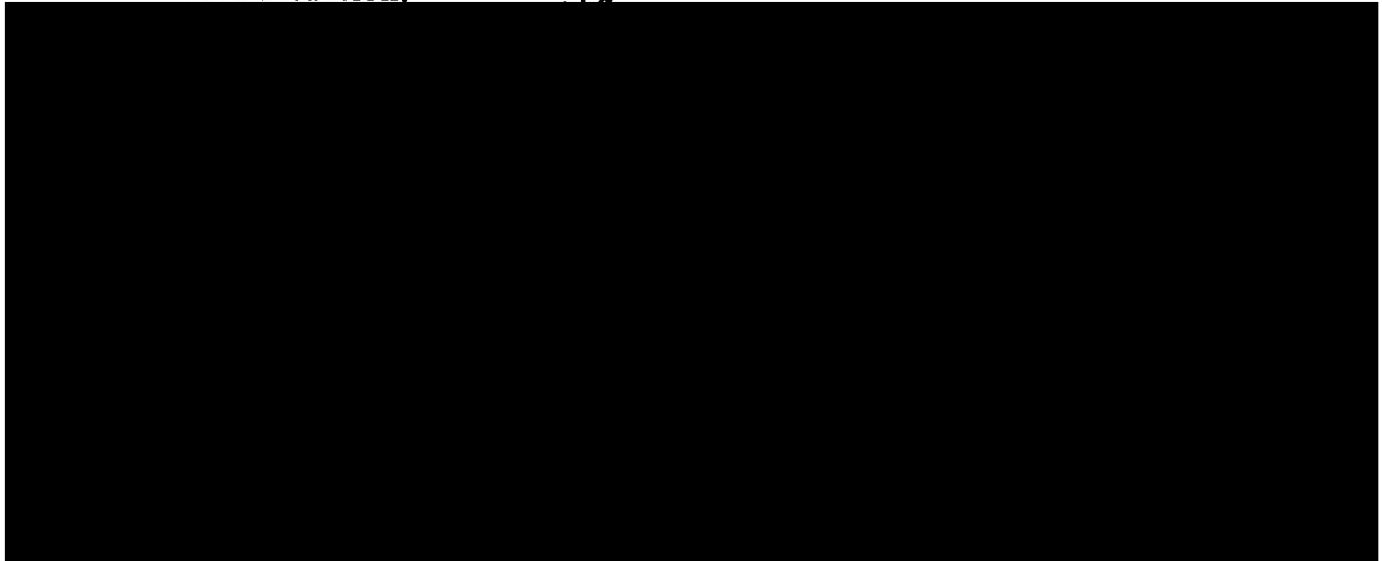

In connection with the forthcoming meeting on 11 June with Congressman Mahon, it should be noted that there is nothing in particular which the Congressman wishes to discuss -- this is just a general courtesy visit at our invitation. However, as I do not believe we have ever seriously discussed the Joint Committee problem with Mr. Mahon, it might be advisable to do so informally in view of the fact that Chairman Richards, of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, among other Democrats, has introduced such a resolution. Other than that, the Congressman may wish to be brought up to date on Soviet bombers and the world situation.
