Thursday - 13 August 1959

1. Jay Sourwine, Senate Internal Security Subcommittee, telephoned referring to the Drew Pearson article in THE WASHINGTON POST today. He requested that they be furnished with a copy of this report. Security was requested to look into the matter and eventually the Director telephoned apparently having been apprised of Sourwine's call. He advised there was no such CIA report and Sourwine was furnished this information. Sourwine said possibly the Subcommittee would direct a letter to the Agency on this matter.

Subsequently, the Director requested that HCUA be advised that this was not a CIA report. Accordingly, Mr. Areas was so advised.

2. [] telephoned to advise that General Starbird and others were going to give the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy a further briefing on the points of detection of nuclear explosions and at first the Director had suggested that [] be present but it was agreed that [] would only attend if the Joint Committee requested it.

3. Senator Henry M. Jackson (D., Wash.) met with the Director with Mr. Warner present in connection with S. Res. 115, the Subcommittee on National Policy Making Machinery. See Memorandum for the Record.

5. Kenneth Mansfield on the staff of the Jackson Subcommittee on National Policy Making Machinery telephoned requesting that Agency representatives meet with the staff to go over the outline of the proposed reports on the Soviet and Chinese Communist policy making machinery. Arrangements were made to meet with them at 2:00 p.m. tomorrow. [] will accompany Mr. Warner and there will be one other Agency representative.
