STAT [redacted] called to see if we could query Senator Ellender further on the requirements specified in their memorandum of 14 November 1957. This will be followed up in coordination with OCB.

The Director has agreed to appear before the Defense Subcommittee of the House Appropriations Committee on 23 January 1958 at 10 o'clock. This will be a general briefing on the Soviets and will be based largely on the briefing provided the CIA Subcommittees of the House Armed Services.

STAT [redacted] indicated that OSI did not wish to comment on the National Science Foundation Act proposals which had been made available to us by Mr. Earl Radley in the Bureau of the Budget. Mr. Radley was advised that we did not wish to make comments.

Mr. Simmons (State Department liaison to CIA) called again in connection with the list of Soviet diplomatic personnel. He advised that the State Department had decided to send to Senator Ellender a list which had been prepared in the Department but asked if they might still have the CIA list for their internal use and comparative purposes. Mr. Simmons was told that since there was no longer congressional interest in connection with our list, their request should be made through normal liaison channels.
